



## British Aerobatic Association Limited Lottery

### Privacy Policy

As with all lottery promoters, we collect certain personal information from you when you purchase a lottery ticket from the British Aerobatic Association ("BAeA").

We use this information to admit you to the specific lottery for which you have purchased a lottery ticket(s) and, following the draw, to inform you when you have been a lucky winner.

Ticket counterfoils are retained for a period of 3 months from the date of the draw, in order to (a) deal with any claims or complaints that may have arisen and (b) to collate mandatory submissions to the local authority with which the BAeA is registered for the purposes of running an authorised lottery (as required by the Gambling Act 2005). However, none of your personal details are included in these submissions which are, effectively, a financial summary which may include:

- > total number of tickets put up for sale
- > total number of tickets sold
- > total proceeds from ticket sales
- > exact amount spent on the prize(s)
- > exact amount spent on associated lottery set-up expenses
- > exact amount donated to any charity from total proceeds
- > exact amount directed to the fund for which the lottery is being run
- > the number of un-sold tickets

Once the deadline for claims or complaints has expired and the respective submission has been approved by the local authority, the counterfoils are then collected by a British Security Industry Association ("BSIA") approved security shredding company (in security containers provided by the shredding company). The shredding company then issues a certificate for each batch of counterfoils, confirming their destruction. Each destruction certificate is then held on file.

The information we collect, onto the lottery ticket counterfoil, is:

- > Your name - so that we know what to call you should we need to contact you
- > Email address - so we can email you if you hold a winning ticket and also to provide you with details of subsequent lottery draws being promoted by the BAeA
- > Your mobile number - so we can, alternatively, text or call you if you hold a winning ticket or we need to inform you of any changes that may affect the planned lottery
- > Your address - in order for us to send you written information you will need if you are a lucky winner

If you are a lucky winner of one of our lotteries, we shall send you, by post, the details you will require so that you may arrange the date of the winning flight (which will need to take account of your own availability, weather contingencies and aircraft availability) with the aircraft operator providing the prize flight.

Your name, address and contact details will be retained on a winners' file until either the expiry date for up-take of the prize flight has been passed (i.e. 12 months from the date of the specific lottery) without you having arranged the flight, or that the aircraft operator confirms to the BAeA that the flight has taken place. Following either of the above outcomes, your name, address and contact details will then be removed from all BAeA files.

## **Data Protection**

The BAeA strictly observes the Data Protection Principles set out in the Data Protection Act 1998, and will only ever pass on your details, with your consent, to the other parties connected with the main elements of the lottery prize (i.e. the organisations directly involved in providing the various elements of the prize, such as aircraft flights and hotel accommodation) in the event of you winning that prize.
